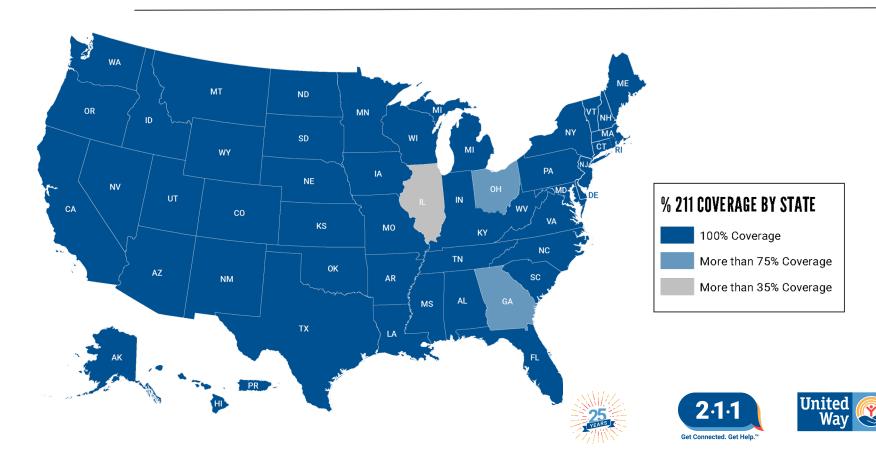

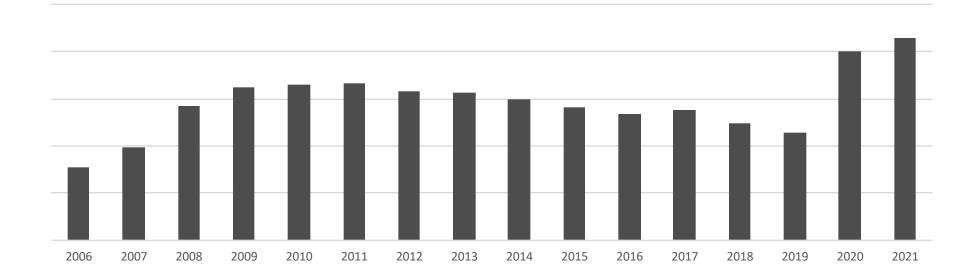








Historical Contact Volume
